Lanes

The bowling alley is located on the first floor of Helen Newman Hall.

General Rules

- Each team shall consist of four members. In CoRec there must be two men and two women. A “dummy” score (male= 100, female= 75) may be used as a substitute for one absent player.
- Substitutions are allowed at the end of each game.
- Scoring will be on a seven point basis distributed in the following:
 - Two points for each game won.
 - One point for most total pins in the three game series.
- The points will accumulate throughout the season and the top two teams in each pool with the highest point value will advance to the playoffs.
- If two teams are tied, and both teams have exhibited acceptable sportsmanship, there will be a bowl-off to determine which team will go to playoffs.

Helen Newman Bowling Center Rules

- Street shoes, food, and beverages must remain on carpeted areas.
- No lofting of bowling balls.
- All teams must start on time.
- No bowling after the completion of the 3rd game.
- Put all bowling balls back on racks and return rental shoes to the desk.
- **Anyone drinking under age will be disqualified. Anyone acting in an intoxicated manner will be disqualified (Legal Limit Age is 21).**
- Any player that is disqualified must meet the Intramural Sports professional staff to be eligible for further participation.
